Malayer Antique Runner 3.10 x 17.3 Botehs and herati. Ecrú and black. A repeat of characteristic leaf-edged ogival Malayer medallions filled with an urban version of the classic herati pattern lightly sets on a brocaded textile version of the boteh (paisley) design in this attractive, finely woven, single wefted c. 1870 Malayer wide runner with an border abrashing from powder blue to sky blue. This is a well conceived and executed town Malayer.
