Mid 18th Century Turkish Ghiordes Courtt Carpet

Description

Carpets from Ghiordes in west Anatolia are particularly rare in room sizes. This published example has an allover posie pattern centered by a sharply drawn lozenge medallion, with eight patterned borders, the widest with a stylized palmette sequence. The weave is fine and the condition is excellent for a mid-18th century rug. The colors have mellowed somewhat with age, but the general tonality of this antique Ghiordes carpet is still clear and crisp.
