## Mid 18th Century Chinese Ningxia Pillar Carpet

## Description

Ningxia in Northern China provided Tibetan monasteries with large numbers of pillar carpets with wraparound dragons soaring above mountains and waves, usually, as here, with originally red, now faded to rich gold, backgrounds. Although reduced at the top, this is still an authentic and dynamic example of the group. This carpet dates from the mid-18th century.
